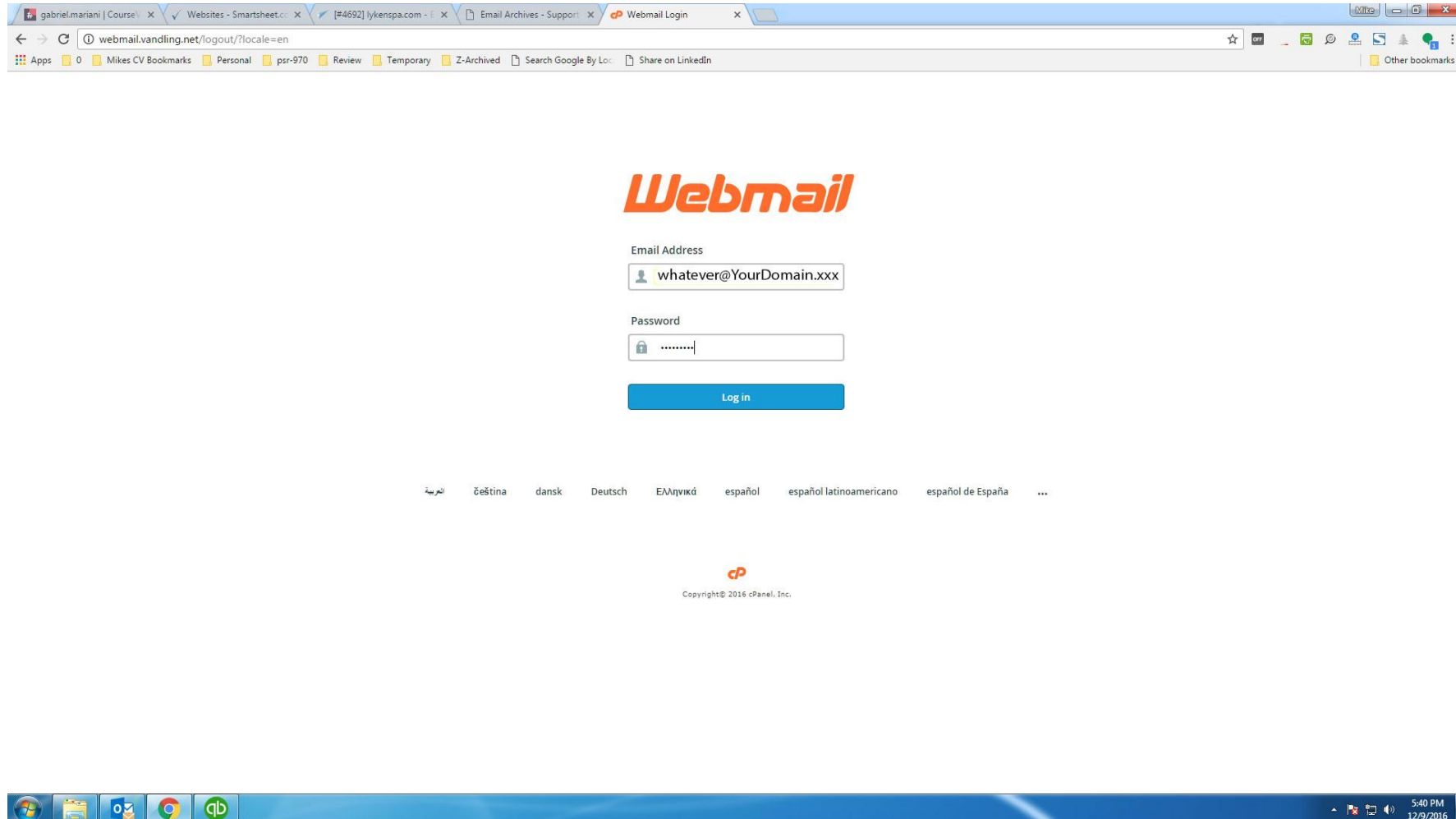


Changing Email Passwords Through Webmail
